1. Narrative description of the Proposition 28 arts education programs funded (2500 character limit).

The District employs 3 VAPA Teachers on Special Assignment (TOSAs) who are strategically assigned across four school sites to ensure consistent access to high-quality arts instruction for all students. Through this model, students receive standards-based instruction in music, dance, and theatre as part of the regular instructional day. Instruction is aligned with the California Visual and Performing Arts Standards. The VAPA program is structured to provide all students, regardless of school site, with meaningful opportunities to engage in the arts. By integrating arts instruction into the core school day, the District ensures that access is not dependent on extracurricular participation, thereby promoting equity and inclusion.
