Option 2

Virtual Online Program for Kindergarten – 6th Grade

Students will participate in structured, full-time virtual online instruction and learning with a class, which will consist of daily online instruction and assignments. Optional weekly in-person class meetings will be offered to students. The in-person class meeting will be scheduled by the teacher. The following program requirements will be in place for families who choose this option:

- School placement for the Virtual Online Program will be based on program enrollment. Students
 may not necessarily be assigned to a teacher at the school he/she regularly attends.
- Class placement for the Virtual Online Program will be offered on a first come first serve basis.
 Parents will be able to select this learning platform as an option during our annual registration process in July.
- Students will be expected to participate in daily live online classes in which attendance will be taken. Students will be expected to participate in the same amount of instructional time as provided for those in the Traditional Learning Option. If a student is not present for the online class, they will be marked absent for the day.
- Parent communication with the Virtual Online Program teacher will be expected. An adult will be expected to be present in the home in order to provide student supervision throughout the instructional day.
- Students enrolled in the Virtual Online Program will be expected to participate in the same length of instructional day as those enrolled in the Traditional Learning Program.
- As with the Traditional Instructional Program, students are expected to maintain regular attendance for the full instructional day. Students who do not maintain regular attendance will be referred to the School Attendance Review Team (S.A.R.T.) and/or the Student Attendance Review Board (S.A.R.B.).
- Optional weekly in-person class meetings will be offered to students. The in-person class meeting will be scheduled by the teacher. During this time, students will check-in with their classroom teacher, review lessons, take assessments, and be provided with materials and/or instruction needed for upcoming lessons. No transportation will be provided for such meetings.
- Please refer to on-campus expectations regarding temperature taking, handwashing, and face coverings.
- Instruction will be aligned to grade level standards and will utilize currently adopted curriculum.
 While most lessons will be able to be completed online, some paper/pencil work may be required.
- Students will be expected to submit completed assignments. Completed assignments can be submitted digitally through an online platform or submitted physically as determined by the teacher.
- Assignments will be graded based upon grade level standards and report cards will be issued at the end of each trimester.
- While most instruction will be provided online, there will be some times students may need to come to the school site to participate in grade level assessments and/or standardized testing.
- Class placements in the traditional program after the school year has begun will be based on availability. If a student is enrolled in the virtual online program and later decides to enroll in the traditional program, we cannot guarantee placement at their home school. If there is no room at the child's home school, the next closest school with space in the Savanna School District will be offered.
